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Outcomes to date:

100% of the children in receipt of FSM in year 6 (2013) made above average progress the year in reading, writing and maths. The pupil premium pupils out performed their non FSM peers in their end of year 6 average point score, 27pts compared with 26.4pts. The average combined point scores for mathematics, reading and writing were 29.1 for non PP pupils and 29.3 for PP pupils.
